PEX-OPPEN01	<b>City Explorer (4 hrs)</b> <i>Tour starts : 0900hrs &amp; 1400hrs</i> Georgetown, the capital city of Penang was named after King George III of England, is an interesting land of the old and new. It is worth to note that Penang has one of the largest Colonial building in South East Asia. Tours include a stop at Fort Cornwallis - built in 1808. Fort Cornwallis also marks the spot where Sir Francis Light first landed on this island. You'll be driven through Street Harmony which houses the Anglican Church, Kuan Yin Chinese Temple, Mahamariamman Indian Temple and the Kapitan Keling Mosque. Followed by a visit to the State Museum, built in 1821 which houses a fine collection of old photographs, maps, charts and pass by the colorful Little India and bustling Chinatown. Ride on the Funicular Railway up to Penang Hill. Next, visit the century old 72-acres Penang Botanical Gardens located at the foot of Penang Hill. Visit Yap Kongsi and Ciji Temple - a clan association built in 1924, a Taoist temple dedicated to "Nan'an" patron deity. Also, you will be taken to Hock Teik Cheng Sin Temple which is the Tua Pek Kong Temple and Hokkien secret society headquarters in the mid 19th century. Another Hokkien Clan Temple - Cheah Kongsi that was founded in 1820 and built in 1858. Last but not least, continu the tour visiting the world renowned Pinang Peranakn Mansion. Baba & Nyonya was a prominent community of accultured Chinese unique to this part of the world which houses over 1,000 pieces of antiques and collectible items of the era on display. Proceed to Butterfly Farm - opened in 1986, the 8 hectares farm is located in Teluk Bahang - a sanctuary houses an impressively varied collection of butterfly species as well as an assortment of other insects. The farm sits at the foot of the Teluk Bahang hills – between the Taman Rimba Park and Teluk Bahang village.
